







## HOW DO I REACH MY COUNSELOR?

Seniors should currently have a minimum of 170 credits Less than 170? See your counselor!

#### Stay eligible!

### UC/CSU ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A. History/Social	2 years:
Science	World History, U.S. History/Government
B. English	4 years: College Prep English
C. Math	3 years of math. 4 years is highly recommended Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2
D. Laboratory Science	2 years of lab science. 3 years is recommended Biology, Chemistry, Physics
E. Language other than	2 years same language, 3 years is recommended.
English	French, Spanish, or ASL, etc.
F. Visual/Performing	1 year of a college prep course from
Arts	Art, Dance, Music, or Theater (drama)
G. College Prep.	1 year of a college prep electives
Elective	ex: Earth Science, Economics, etc.
Test Requirements	SAT or ACT not utilized for UC; temporarily suspended for CSU through Fall of 2022 admissions



## Key differences

### HS GRADUATION

- ➔ D or higher is passing
- $\rightarrow$  Math: 3 years
- → World Language: 1 year

### College Entrance


- → Grades C or higher
- → Math Must include:
  - ♦ Geometry
  - Algebra 2 or higher
- → World Language:
  - 2 years <u>OR</u> Level 2
- Tests: SAT or ACT may be required for private or out-of-state schools
- → Demonstrated college readiness; multiple measures

## A-G GRADUATION CORD


- → Seniors who meet the A-G course requirement
- → Red, White and Blue cord will be worn at graduation
- → CVCHS will provide the cord
- → Check your transcript & A-G req's to see if you are eligible!

## CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY

#### NUMBER OF CAMPUSES: → 23

#### **R**EQUIREMENTS:

- → A-G Requirements
- → 2.5 Academic GPA or Higher
- → 2.0 2.49 GPA; supplemental factors

#### WHAT THEY OFFER:

- → Bachelor's Degrees (4 years)
- → Master's Degrees (2 years)



## CSU - CHANGES DUE TO COVID-19

- → A-G Coursework STILL REQUIRED
- → 2.0 Academic GPA or Higher
  - 2.49+ GPA Automatically *eligible*
  - 2.00-2.49 = Evaluated based on "supplemental factors"
- → SAT Reasoning <u>or</u> ACT Exam -SUSPENDED
  - May still be used for future placement
  - Can be used for multiple measures math and English placement


- → Bachelor's & Master's Degrees

### UC - CHANGES DUE TO COVID-19

- → A-G Requirements STILL REQUIRED
- $\rightarrow$  3.0 GPA of Higher
- → SAT Reasoning or ACT Exam w/ writing NOT USED FOR ADMISSIONS CONSIDERATION
- → PIQ's & Extracurricular Activities --focus on past and current accomplishments
- → Additional Comments Sections:
  - Highlight *significant* strides or obstacles due to COVID-19 or social justice movements

#### REQUIREMENTS:

- Most will require similar to A-G Coursework, may require SAT or ACT
- Many require an essay and letters of recommendation ... Double-check their websites for admissions requirements!

#### WHY APPLY OUT OF STATE?

- Higher Admit Rates
- → Higher 4-year Completion Rates
- Potential Scholarships
- → WUE Western Undergraduate Exchange Program:
  - 16 western states participate

## PRIVATE/OUT OF STATE COLLEGES – CHANGES DUE TO COVID



- Colleges and universities across the country have been reviewing their admission requirements.
- → Students should visit each college's admissions webpage for current information about changes to their process.
- → Students can also search for <u>FairTest.org</u> to access a database of test-optional colleges.

### EARLY ACTION VS EARLY DECISION

NACAC's Early Decision Self-Evaluation Questionnaire

### EARLY DECISION

- → Deadline tends to be November 1<sup>st</sup> (including test scores)
- $\rightarrow$  BINDING on the student
- → Apply to ONLY ONE ED college
- Must withdraw other applications if accepted to ED school

### EARLY ACTION

- → Deadline tends to be
   November 1<sup>st</sup> (including test scores)
- $\rightarrow$  NOT binding
- → Can continue to apply to other schools

## COLLEGE BOUND STUDENT ATHLETES: NCAA

- Register for NCAA!!!!! Tonight!!! (Eligibilitycenter.org)
- → Complete a total of 16 Core Courses in:
  - English, Math, Science, Social Science, Foreign Language
  - 10 of the 16 core must be completed <u>PRIOR</u> to Senior year
  - Earn over a 2.3 GPA DI; 2.2 for DII (in your 16 core)
  - SAT/ACT Scores (SUSPENDED due to COVID)
- → Not all courses are approved for NCAA-work with your School Counselor (especially online courses!)
- → Need to repeat a class? See your School Counselor for options

## SAT

#### → <u>www.collegeboard.com</u> Cost \$55 (essay eliminated)

- → October 2 (deadline to regis
  - (deadline to register 9/3)
  - November 6 (deadline to register 10/8)
- December 4
  - (deadline to register 11/4) (Late registration add \$30.00)




- → <u>www.actstudent.org</u> Cost is \$85 (includes writing)
  - October 23

     (deadline to register 9/17)
  - December 11

(deadline to register 11/5) (Late registration add \$36.00) Colleges usually want scores no later than December test date.

<u>\*If</u> you are on Free/Reduced lunch, see Ms.Gonzalez for a fee waiver.

DVC will visit w/Seniors in the Spring. Seniors will need to sign up to attend in Naviance.





- → AA/AS Degrees (2 years)
- → Vocational Training
- → Certificate Programs

#### \*Can Start Applying in Spring 2022\*

- → <u>www.cccco.edu</u> (Explore/Searches)
- → <u>www.cccapply.org</u> (Start Application)
  - It's a common application most campuses use but not all.
  - English & Math Placement based on multiple measures
- → Apply for financial aid (FAFSA/Dream Act) and Scholarships
- → Explore campuses outside the area
- → Make sure they offer what you are looking for





## HOW MANY SCHOOLS SHOULD I APPLY TO?

- Have a mix of Reach, Target, and Safety Schools
- Do your research! Naviance has a great search tool under the Colleges Tab
- 5-8 is a typical number of applications

#### THE APPLICATION PROCESS

#### 1. Applications... online for most



# THE APPLICATION PROCESS (CONTINUED...) 2. Test Scores\* ... must be sent directly from the testing agency achieve more with WRITING

#### THE APPLICATION PROCESS (CONTINUED...)

- 3. Transcripts... generally requested later in the process
- School MUST be listed in Naviance!!
- Initial Transcripts <u>NOT</u> required for CSU or UC



#### THE APPLICATION PROCESS (CONTINUED...)

4. Essays

- <u>NOT</u> required for CSU
- Are required by UC (Personal Insight Questions)
- Required by most private colleges and many out-of-state colleges and universities

#### THE APPLICATION PROCESS (CONTINUED...) 5. Letters of Recommendation

- <u>NOT</u> required for CSU or UC
- Are required by most private colleges and many out-of-state schools
- Do <u>NOT</u> ask for one unless you are 100% sure that your college requires them
- Minimum 2 weeks notice
- Requested through Naviance
- Brag sheet must be completed in Naviance (About Me tab)

## THE 4 TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

LOANS

- → Free Money for educational expenses based on financial need
- ➔ Main Types:

College Bound

- <u>Cal-Grant</u>
- <u>Pell Grant</u>

- → Jobs to help pay for school
- Employment at the campus
- Up to 15 hours per week
- → Free money based on specific requirements or criteria
- → Main Types:
  - 1. On Campus
  - 2. National
  - 3. Local

- → Money on loan which must be paid back with interest
- <u>Subsidized:</u> Government pays down interest while in school
- <u>Unsubsidized:</u> Automatic monthly payments

<u>NWW.FAFSA.ED.GOV</u> AND <u>WWW.CSAC.CA.GOV (DREAM ACT)</u>



#### FAFSA <u>https://fafsa.ed.gov</u>

- → Free Application for Federal Student Aid
- $\rightarrow$  Baseline application for all student aid
- → Determines eligibility for grants, work study, parent and student loans
- → Required also for Cal Grant application processing
- $\rightarrow$  Make sure address on FAFSA matches PS address.
- → Criteria: U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents, or have been granted asylum (have a SSN).
- → Starts October 1 this year!!!! Use prior-prior year tax information. Taxes from 2 years ago (2020).
- → Complete by March 2



#### CAL DREAM A(T https://dream.csac.ca.gov/

- → Criteria: Students who do <u>NOT</u> have a SSN or have one from completed DACA/Visa.
  - Must have attended a CA school for at least 3 years and will graduate from a CA high school/GED and will be attending a CA college.
- → Required also for Cal Grant application processing
- → Starts October 1 this year!!!! Use prior-prior year tax information. Taxes from 2 years ago (2020).
- → Complete by March 2

### HOW DOES FINANCIAL AID WORK?

Colleges determine and offer their students financial aid based on the following equation:

COST OF ATTENDANCE (COA)

- EXPECTED FAMILY CONTRIBUTION (EFC)

• FINANCIAL NEED (FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY)

EFC is generated from your FAFSA.



### CHECK YOUR CAL GRANT STATUS

Set up your WebGrants Account: https://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov/

Note: GPAs are uploaded by CVCHS to the CSAC prior to 10/1 deadline.

- Check Cal Grant award status
- Confirm student's high school graduation as required
- Make changes to Cal Grant school choices
- View how much a Cal Grant is worth at different California Colleges & Universities
- View Cal Grant payment history

#### FAFSA: Free Application for Federal Student Aid <u>HTTPS://FAFSA.ED.GOV</u>

o Opens October 1<sup>st</sup> / Deadline is March 2<sup>nd</sup>

#### Cal Grants: (CVCHS = automatic)


- o Deadline is March 2<sup>nd</sup>
- o CVCHS electronically uploads GPAs to California Student Aid Commission by October 1st; no paper applications.



2. Match your Common App in Naviance by using your Common App email	Contact the teacher and request in Naviance*	
Enables counselors/teachers to send LOR's, transcripts, etc.	Can be requested for ALL or SPECIFIC colleges	
	"Colleges" tab+ "Add Request"	
*Meet with counselor if need a counselor letter of recommendation;		

\*Meet with counselor if need a counselor letter of recommendation brag sheet must be completed in Naviance.
